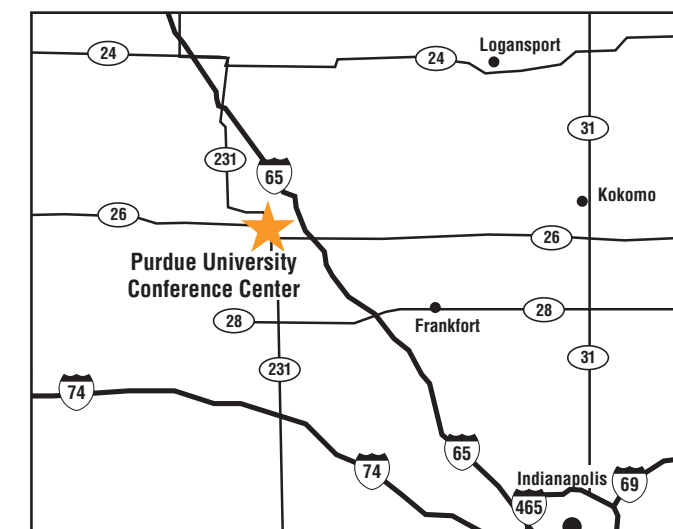

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

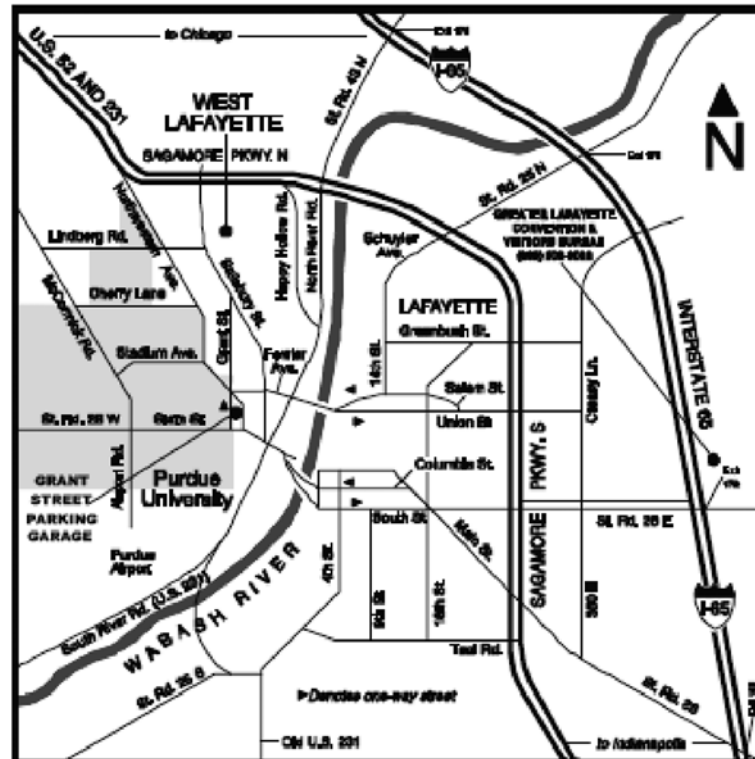
From Chicago: Take I-65 South to exit #178, S.R. 43. Follow S.R. 43 south to West Lafayette (approximately seven miles). Turn right on S.R. 26 West and drive up the hill. At the second stop light, turn right onto Grant Street. You will see the Grant Street Parking Garage immediately on your right.

From Indianapolis: Take I-65 north to exit #172, S.R. 26. Follow signs for S.R. 26 west through Lafayette (approximately seven miles). Cross the bridge and proceed up the hill. At the fourth stop light after the bridge turn right onto Grant Street. You will see the Grant Street Parking Garage immediately on your right.

Leaving Purdue University's Grant Street Parking Garage: Take a left immediately after leaving the Grant Street Parking Garage. Turn right at the stop sign onto Grant Street. At the next stoplight, turn right onto Northwestern and follow the curve to the left onto Wiggins Street, following the signs for U.S. 231. Proceed through two stoplights on Wiggins Street. At the Salisbury Street intersection take the down ramp on the right.

To Chicago: At the bottom of the ramp, turn left onto S.R. 43 and proceed to I-65.

To Indianapolis: At the bottom of the ramp, turn right onto S.R. 43. At the second light, turn left onto S.R. 26. Follow S.R. 26 across the bridge and through Lafayette until you reach I-65.
