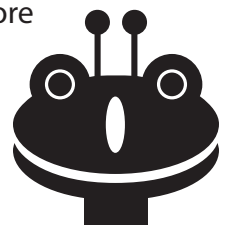

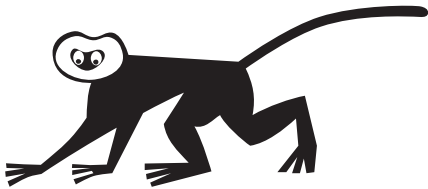

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From the North: Bloomington is 50 mi. south of Indianapolis. Take Hwy 37 South to College Ave. exit. Take College Ave. to 3rd and College. Continue straight thru the intersection. The Convention Center is on the right. Parking is south of the Courtyard by Marriott.

From the South: Take Hwy 37 North to the 3rd St. exit. Turn right onto 3rd St. It will become 5th St. Follow 5th St. to College Ave. Turn right on College Ave. Go straight thru the 3rd St. intersection. The Convention Center is on the right. Parking is south of the Courtyard by Marriott.

From the East: Enter Bloomington on Highway 46 (going west), which will become 3rd Street. Follow to 3rd and College Ave. Turn left on College Ave. The Convention Center is on the right. Parking is south of the Courtyard by Marriott.

From the West

From Hwy 45 (Bloomfield), take Hwy 37 North to the 3rd St. exit, and turn right onto 3rd Street. From Hwy 46 (Ellettsville), take Hwy 37 South to the 3rd St. exit, and turn left onto 3rd St. Highway 48 (Whitehall) will become 3rd St. 3rd St. will become 5th St. Follow 5th St. to College Ave. Turn right on College Ave. Go straight thru the 3rd St. intersection.
